


## WHAT YARN TO USE FOR MY ITEM/WHAT CAN I MAKE WITH MY YARN (Draft Only V1.0)

### General notes

This is for Knitting/Crocheting etc. See **What Fabric What Item** for Sewing Items

Please don't use 'knobbly yarn' - animals may suck on the bits

No lacy patterns - animals may get stuck in the holes

### Notes to the table

# Micro Pouches must be Natural fibres only,

Size 24cm x 12cm, then folded and sewn for 12cm x 12cm pouch

Outer Pouches can be various sizes, see patterns

\* Need to be sturdy

^ Sewn only, Don't worry if you don't sew, there will be other members

who can make the liners
